WARANA TIME

FOR A REGENERATIVE WORKFLOW

WARANA (original Guaraná of the Satéré Mawé people) is a powerful adaptogenic energizer that supports focus, vitality, and sustained performance. Traditionally, it is also a social catalyst — much like an ancestral version of the “apéro” — symbolizing communal gathering, collective enthusiasm and the power of speech. Referred to mythically as “**the eye of the forest**”, Warana embodies the living intelligence of the rainforest and invites us to reconnect with the informational networks of the natural world.

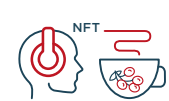
IN YOUR ORGANIZATION

WE OFFER AN IMMERSIVE WORKSHOP THAT WEAVES INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE : **through the story of Warana**, the legacy of its original guardians, the Satéré Mawé, and their longstanding ethical sourcing partnership with **GUAYAPI**.

The session culminates in a guided, **ceremonial-style degustation** — anchoring attention, intention, and respect for plant-based intelligence.

Each participant receives a **Warana Workflow Pack**, including a Warana tasting box and a symbolic NFT featuring meditative soundscapes inspired by the Indigenous cultural value chain.

THE ART OF LIVING GEOMETRY

KENE is the ancestral visual language and cultural identity of the Shipibo-Konibo People of the Peruvian Amazon. These intricate patterns reflect a refined and energetic perception of the cosmos, representing the deep interconnection of all life.

Each Kené design is received in visionary states by trained knowledge keepers, along with specific healing songs (ikaros). More than just visual art, Kené murals are energetic pathways for coherence, healing, and harmony—shared as a form of community medicine.
